

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQ)

GENERAL

What is Parcel Drone Competition?

This inaugural competition is organised by Pos Malaysia Berhad in collaboration with Malaysian Communications and Multimedia Commission (MCMC).

It aims to create public awareness on drone technology, testing new technology for parcel delivery and at the same time accelerate innovation in postal and courier industry. In addition, this competition will also help to build drone ecosystem and develop parcel drone technology commercially in Malaysia.

We are looking for individuals and Malaysian companies with the best drone to deliver parcel. You could have a chance at winning the grand prize of RM25,000.

RATIONALE

Rationale of this competition mainly due to the following;

- i. Provide awareness to public on drone technology
- ii. Testing new technology for parcel delivery in postal and courier industry
- iii. To accelerate innovation in postal and courier industry
- iv. Develop market for parcel drone delivery.

ELIGIBILITY

Who can participate?

The competition is open to all who meet the following criteria:

- i. Any Malaysian citizen with a valid MyKad or a company incorporated in Malaysia. (Pos Malaysia Group of Companies, 2Cool Productions Sdn. Bhd. and MCMC including its shareholders or related corporation or their respective employees and family members are not qualified to participate in this Competition); and
- ii. Those who possess the full knowledge and skills to operate drones and conversant with the rules and regulations in the Malaysian aviation industry.

APPLICATION PROCESS

How to participate in the contest?

To participate, applicants are required to:

- i. Fill out the registration form online at drone.pos.com.my and submit the following documents:
 - A fully completed competition registration form;
 - Company profile (for businesses);
 - A copy of the participant's MyKad or Malaysian passport (for individuals);
 - Copy of Business Registration SSM (Form 9); and
 - Copy of Shareholding Status (Form 24/49).
- ii. A proposal which includes the proposed drone design and specifications; estimated cost of system and development, experience and track record of the entrant in terms of similar systems built, and/or relevant tests/projects conducted in the past; and
- iii. Video, still images and supporting documentation to prove that the drone system is "capable".

JUDGING

Who are the judges?

Professional judges who have experiences in drone and aviation industry.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

What are the entry requirements?

Contestants must build an autonomous battery powered multirotor drone which is able to safely carry a maximum payload of 2kg over a distance of approximately 2 km. The details of the drone design and specifications can be referred in the [competition terms and conditions](#).

EVALUATION CRITERIA

What are the evaluation criteria?

Participants will be judged based on speed, maneuverability, accuracy and stability of the drone in delivering the parcel to and fro the points as described in [competition terms and condition](#).

THE PRIZES

What are the prizes offered to the winner?

The winners will be awarded with cash prizes as follows:

Grand prize : RM25,000
2nd place : RM15,000
3rd place : RM 7,000
4th to 7th place : RM 1,000 each
